### RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 15-TM-36

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA; THAT**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well-being of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells and is the parent council of said bands; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Council instructed staff to form the Te-Moak Comp Plan Committee to work with all four communities to conduct a comprehensive planning process; and

**WHEREAS**, significant outreach efforts were conducted including two meetings in each of the four Te-Moak communities, making a total of eight (8) community meetings, three newsletter and three newspaper layouts, one dedicated Facebook page titled "Planning for Our Future", and 6 comment drop boxes placed throughout our communities, in addition to informal communications with Band staff and Council members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Committee succeeded in gathering meaningful input from Tribal members, their families and friends as is evidenced by 1) residents' expressing their visions for the future of our tribe and their communities; and then 2) voting on which of the goals they created were the highest priorities for achievement; and

**WHEREAS**, this participation can be measured by the more than 364 comments that were gathered and summarized in the attached planning goals that express the consensus the vision of future goals that benefit all Te-Moak Bands equally;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, this resolution serves to adopt the attached comprehensive planning goals as the official long term planning tool that will serve the Te-Moak Tribe and its constituent Bands as we move forward to achieve the self-sustaining future that these goals envision.
