RESOLUTION NO: 15-TM-20

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA THAT:

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well-being of its members; **and**

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribal Council is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; **and**

WHEREAS, the South Fork Band Council by Resolution No. 15-SF-18, concerning the removal of four miles of old roadway on SFIR-Lee Road and replace the old with new asphalt in 2014 resulting a checklist of construction items that needed to be added or changed before the road construction contract can be finished, did approved the Agency Superintendent to prepare the necessary additional Right of Ways, reference attached South Fork Band Council's resolution 15-SF-19 for additional details, **and**


WHEREAS, the Eastern Nevada Agency Superintendent informed the South Fork Band that a concurring resolution form the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone on SFBC Resolution 15-SF-19 in necessary for the BIA to perform the assistance as described in the SFBC resolution 15-SF-19 (attached).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Te-Moak Council supports and concurs with the South Fork Band resolution No. 15-SF-19, as explained therein, authorizing the Eastern Nevada Agency Superintendent to prepare the necessary Right of Ways, or easement for the SFIR-Lee Road.


C-E-R-T-I-F-I-C-A-T-I-O-N
