RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF THE WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 16-TM-27

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF THE WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA THAT

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, as amended, to exercise right of home rule and to be responsible for the promotion and social welfare of its tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe is the parent council for the communities of the Battle Mountain Band, Elko Band, South Fork Band and Wells Band, and

WHEREAS, the South Fork Band Council has submitted resolution 16-SF-17 for the BIA Tribal Priority Allocation funding for the amount of \$37, 969 to perform road maintenance work on BIA Route #1 and gravel improved roadways on the South Fork Band Reservation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED this resolution confirms and approves the request for the South Band Council of \$37,969 for roads improvements and maintenance.
